

Fitt's fab five medal haul

Swimming

OLIVER Fitt was the outstanding St Ives swimmer at the East Regional Bagcat Championships in Norwich.

Held over the past two weekends, 10-year-old Fitt defeated competition from six counties and even showed himself to be up with the best in the UK, picking up five medals from the eight events he entered.

His gold medals in the 100m and 200m backstroke left him ranked top in Cambridgeshire, and respectively fourth and fifth fastest in his age group nationally.

He boosted his medal haul by taking a further

two silver medals and a bronze from from the championships.

Also competing for St Ives Swimming Club was 12-year-old Peter Todd, who qualified for 10 races

across the four strokes, reaching two finals. Ten-year-old Hazel Sterling qualified for seven races and reached a final, promoting her into the top three in the county. Gio-

vanni Di Siena, 11, swam two races and is ranked fourth in the county in the backstroke, while Jenny Hookham, 10, achieved the qualifying times in two races
