Questions & Answers

These Questions & Answers are broken up into three categories.

SEARCHING

Do I have to register to use [easysearch](#) & how much does it cost?

No. Just use the unique web address of the cause you are supporting and you will raise funds for them & it is completely FREE.

[easyfundraising](#) – the online shop requires registration – which is FREE to all supporters.

How do I guarantee [easysearch](#) will earn my cause money?

By making it your default homepage & browser.

Both options are available to set up on the left side of the home page under WIDGETS – just click the link & follow the instructions.

Will all browsers accept [easysearch](#) as my home page?

Internet Explorer, & most other well known browsers, have no issues with using the links under WIDGETS to set [easysearch](#) as the default homepage & browser.

I don't want to set [easysearch](#) as my home page?

Not a problem keep your home page as it is and add [easysearch](#) to your favourites – then when you've finished with your home page access [easysearch](#) via that.

Is [easysearch](#) as fast or as good as Google?

[easysearch](#) incorporates results from several major search engines such as Yahoo, Bing, Ask – to name a few – that makes [easysearch](#) a “super” search engine enabling it to provide the best results quickly & easily.

With my old browser my history was retained will this be the case?

Yes. In fact just type in one word i.e. facebook and it should be there & go searching.

Can [easysearch](#) be used abroad?

Yes. Because supporters can use a search engine from anywhere in the world – hence world wide web J

They can raise funds for you using any form of machine that they use to access the internet i.e. PC, laptop, mobile phone, gaming machine, etc.

I don't shop online can I still support my cause?

Yes, by using [easysearch](#).

Can I go straight to [easyfundraising](#) from [easysearch](#)?

Yes, by clicking on the [easyfundraising](#) tab (top of page to the right of Web Pages, Images, Video, News tabs)

What if I have two causes I want to support?

If you have two machines not a problem – set one up for one cause and the other up for the other cause

If you only have one machine you will have to decide which cause you support at which time i.e. one week on one & the next week on the other J

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BUSINESS

Can businesses use this service?

Absolutely, in fact this is probably one of the easiest ways to get lots of people using [easysearch](#) to generate funds for your cause. Any company, regardless of size, can use [easysearch](#) for their online searching. This can be a very lucrative way to raise funds for your cause & may be a better way to get a company to donate to your cause.

MONEY

How often is the home page updated with donation amount?

Every weekend, normally Saturday, all supporters will be able to see how much **collectively** has been raised so far. To see the accounting for the updated amount click "[what does this mean](#)"? (bottom right of the page) – normally the period is about 9 days behind the actual date.

Why is the amount raised not up to date?

Because [easysearch](#) don't receive reports from their search engine partners daily, hence the date difference.

Who has contributed to the amount shown?

Everyone who has used the page to perform a **completed** search.

What is a completed search?

To complete a search – set [easysearch](#) as your default browser – in either the address bar or the [easysearch](#) search field type in the name of who you want to search for i.e. facebook,nationwide, etc – press ENTER and the list of choices will appear. Once you click on the link of your choice you have completed the search **J**

What is the difference between [easysearch](#) & [easyfundraising](#)?

They are two different things – [easysearch](#) is a search engine. [easyfundraising](#) is an online shop that people register with for FREE! Then every time your supporters want to shop online they need to login into the site - find the retailer they want and then click the link (donation to be earned is shown on the link) - by clicking the link the donation is tracked back to your cause.

How much will you raise for your cause?

For every **completed** search you make your cause will receive 50% of the fees [easysearch](#) receive from their advertisers (about half a penny). Doesn't sound like much but its estimated if your supporters do 10 completed searches a day they would raise over £20 a year & if your cause has 10, 50, 100 or more members all doing the same then it becomes a very sizeable donation

Is there any way I wont raise money for my cause using [easysearch](#)?

Yes. If your supporters use their "favourites" they wont be raising any funds for you
